## 2022 Chantilly Shock Girls AAU

### Chantilly Shock Girls AAU Basket Chantilly Youth Association (CYA)

#### Girls 3<sup>rd</sup> grade through 11<sup>th</sup> grade

Overall cost estimates vary depending on the age group, the division, and the number of tournaments played. Expenses will likely be higher this year because of the increased cost for gym space with many county gyms closed.

The estimated core costs include the following:

- Uniforms (paid individually as needed)
- Gym space & Equipment
- Approximately 6 tournaments
  - Coaches may elect to participate in more tournaments resulting in additional costs

There are two practices a week of 1.5 hours each and the season typically runs from March – June.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> grade developmental teams

- Core costs should be approximately \$425
- The focus is on introducing the players to the AAU style of basketball
- Usually a lighter schedule than the older and more advanced teams
- Approximately 6 tournaments

#### 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade

- Core costs should be approximately \$500
- Focus is on moving the players to the next level of play and competitiveness with additional tournaments and opportunities
- Approximately 2 additional tournaments for a total of around 8 tournaments

#### 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade

- Core costs should be approximately \$500 (still around 8 tournaments)
- The focus is preparing the players for High School basketball

#### 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade

- Core costs should be approximately \$650 for 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> grades and \$985 for Showcase Elite Team
  - Initial payment of \$395 for the 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> grades due upon team selection
  - Initial payment of \$575 for the Showcase split in two installments ½ due upon team selection and the remainder in six weeks.
  - The remainder for each team will be determined by the end of May and the final payment arrangements made then
- The focus
  - Preparing for High School varsity basketball
  - Preparing for college basketball for those interested
- Approximately 2 showcase tournaments for a total of around 10 tournaments

The **costs do not include** uniforms or any travel or lodging for the away tournaments. That is paid by the individual families. CYA keeps all costs down to a minimum to make the program as cost effective as possible. Gym fees will likely increase the overall cost this year because of limited county space.

**Final costs** will be determined once the teams are selected and the tournaments established.
